Steven Truxal is Professor Air and Space Law and Director at the International Institute of Air and Space Law at Leiden University, the Netherlands. Previously, Steven held the positions of Reader in Air Law and Associate Dean (International) at City, University of London, and Visiting Professor and Dean of Studies at the Centre for British Studies, Humboldt University of Berlin. Before pursuing his career in academia, Steven held positions at Deutsche Lufthansa AG and within the International Trade Administration at the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Steven has a track record of excellence in research and teaching, and is regularly invited to speak at academic conferences, to the media (incl. CNN, Deutsche Welle, BBC World News, USA Today, Reuters, Financial Times, South China Morning Post) and at industry events (incl. twice as the Chair of The Future of Air Transport annual conference in London).
